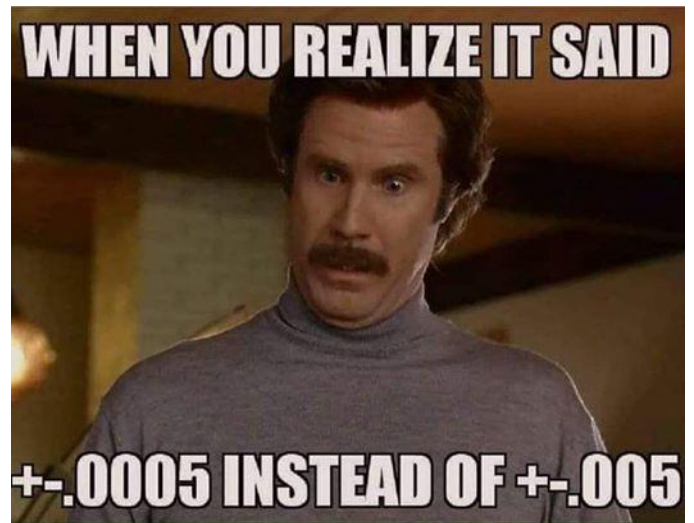
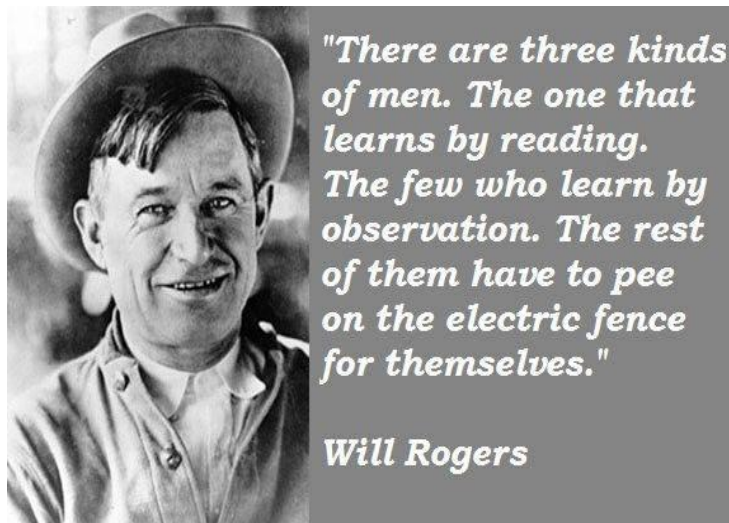

If you registered with the FAA before the deadline in January of 2017, your registration was scheduled to expire. Great news! The FAA has extended your registration.

You can confirm that your registration was extended by logging into the FAA drone site. If you forgot the password you used, just click on the "forgot password" link and the FAA will send you an email to reset your password. You can print a registration card with the new expiration date, or have the FAA email you a PDF of the new card.
