Meeting Minutes for June 29, 2021

- MARKS June 2021 membership meeting
- SRS UAS Facility @ Salisbury Airport
- 13 Members present
- Called to order at 7 pm by President Wally Makuchal
- Jason Taylor with motion to forgo reading of previous minutes. Motion passed.
- John Haffner with treasurer report. John noted a 20.00 expense this month for the MARKSRC domain name. Motion made and passed to approve the report as read.

Jim Waybright Field Report:

- The lifting rod broke off of the deck on the 42" cut John Deere mower. I took it to RD Grier to have it welded. After about two weeks of run around, I gave up and went to John Deere and bought a new one. Ray Carlson and Dave Hess were able to figure out how it went back together and reassembled it. Thanks guys! The root cause of the failure was that it would accidentally get caught under the table top when trying to mow close to the tables in the pit. The corrective action was to saw off about one inch of the rod so it can't get caught under the table top.
- The 50" White mower needed new blades. I normally purchase them at Lowes for about \$50.00. When I checked they had raised their price to \$71.00. I checked on Amazon and found a set of Oregon brand for \$31.21 shipped. Caje installed the blades on the mower. Thanks Caje!
- I received a \$20.00 donation and put it in the munchies fund.
- We are mowing about once a week, usually on Thursday afternoon.
- All the mowers are now in running order.
