Meeting Minutes for May 19, 2024

- MARKS May 2024 membership meeting
- Waybright Field
- 10 members present.
- The meeting was called to order at 2:14 pm by President Jason Taylor.
- A motion was made to forgo reading the April minutes. The motion was seconded and approved. There were no changes or corrections to the minutes.

Treasurer's Report

- Jon couldn't make the meeting, but left copies of the MARKS financial report at the field.
- The major expenses this month were for the porta-potty, electricity, and various mowing related expenses.
- Two additional members have paid their dues this month. A total of 31 members have paid their dues so far this year.
- A motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report. The motion was seconded and approved.

Field Report

- Dave Hess couldn't make the meeting, but he gave the information to Jim Waybright, who read Dave's report.
- John Burnett has been keeping the fields mowed again this month. Scott Richards has been doing the string trimming.
- The first aid signs have been hung on and in the shed by Jim Waybright and Rick Witherow.
- The rope on the flag pole was replaced by John Burnett. John said it was damaged from the shingles blowing off of the roof.
- No expense report will be submitted this month. The only purchase so far is gas for the mowers.

Safety Report

- Chris Tyler provided training in CPR and first aid before the meeting. Chris brought two CPR manikins and a CPR bag for his training and for members to practice on. The training was well received. Thank you, Chris, for your training.
- Wally Makuchal is working on a sign indicating for 911 calls, the field address is MARKS RC.
- Jim Waybright will be putting a clipboard and pen next to the first aid kit in the shed, so we can note which items from the kit have been used and need to be replaced.

Membership Report

- Jason Taylor reported that we have 31 paid members, including three new members.
- Jason will be contacting those members who paid last year and have yet to pay this year to see if there is still any interest in joining. Someone mentioned that John Heinz will be renewing his membership, once his recovery from his hip and knee surgeries allows him to fly again.

Old Business

- Jason Taylor said he plans to come out to the field on Memorial Day, Monday, May 27 to do the painting at the field (pavilion ceiling and table tops). He asked that if anyone else is available that day, to please come out and assist. The more members we have working, the faster it will go.
- Jason Taylor reminded everyone that the airshow is scheduled for Sunday, October 6. John Burnett was concerned that with the October date, if anyone is inspired to fly and join the club, it is almost winter, which leaves few dates for flying. He thought that our typical June date allowed more time for someone, if interested, to explore flying and possibly join the club. Jason indicated what John said makes sense, but at this point there isn't time to get the AMA sanction, do the necessary advertising and print out flyers before a June date. Someone mentioned doing the event in July or August, but everyone felt with the hot, humid weather and lack of shade for the spectators, dates in July or August wouldn't work either. It was also thought that dates in September wouldn't work because of all the back-to-school activities. It was decided to keep the October date for this year, but aim for June next year. Jason mentioned if we want to do it in June next year, we'll have to start planning for the event at our January meeting.
