Meeting Minutes for June 24, 2025

- MARKS June 2025 membership meeting
- Waybright Field
- 7 members present.
- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Vice President Ray Carlson.
- A motion was made to forgo reading the May minutes. The motion was seconded and approved. There were no changes or corrections to the minutes.

Treasurer's Report

- Jon Watson handed out copies of the Treasurer's Report.
- Major expenses were for gas for the mowers, rent and cleaning of the porta potty, and electricity.
- Income was from one member paying dues.
- There have been 33 members that have paid their dues for 2025.
- A motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report. The motion was seconded and approved.

Field Report

- John Burnett has been keeping the fields and mowers in good shape again this month.
- Jim Waybright said the sprinklers are on and appear to be working. Ray Carlson said John Burnett told him that one of the sprinkler heads needs to be replaced. A motion was made to buy new sprinkler heads. The motion was seconded and approved. Jim Waybright said he would purchase the necessary sprinkler heads.
- Bob McIntyre donated $\frac{3}{4}$ gallon of farmer's grade Roundup to kill weeds at the field. It needs to be mixed with water and we need a pump sprayer to apply it. Shye Sarig said he would donate the pump sprayer. Thank you, Bob and Shye.

Safety Report

- Ray Carlson asked whether anyone has taken a look at the fire extinguishers to see if they are up to date and still operational. Steve Hallman said he would take a look at them and give a report on their condition at our July meeting.

Membership Report

No report.

Old Business

- Jason Taylor sent an email to the membership indicating that the sanction for the October Air Show has been approved by the AMA. He also said he has posted the flyer and is starting to share the event on multiple platforms. Shye Sarig has talked to Dave Mangione, from the Delaware Radio Control Club, about flying his F-18 jet at our air show. When he talked to him earlier, he didn't know the date, but now that the date has been set, he would try to contact him again to inform him of the date.
- Jason Taylor was supposed to contact Bill Young about the potential location and design elements (jumps) for a RC car track. No one at the meeting, knew whether Jason had been in contact with Bill and what the result of those conversations was.
- Jason Taylor indicated in his email that is he still planning to hold a Wor-Wic Summer Scholars field trip to Waybright Field on Thursday, July 24. He plans to send a follow up email as the date gets closer. Weather permitting, he wants to put on an airshow for the students. He is estimating 15 – 40 in attendance. It may be one single trip or a morning and afternoon visit from two groups. If you have any questions, please contact Jason. Ray Carlson thought that he remembered that Wally Makuchel and John Burnett volunteering to fly at the event. Ray said he would try to make it if he can and Shye Sarig said he would also try to participate. Bob McIntyre said there are two Boy Scout Troops in the Salisbury area, with one of them meeting at the Salisbury School, that we could invite to Jason's event and even the October air show.

New Business

- Ray Carlson asked if anyone knew anything about the condition of the bridge over the drainage ditch and if any repairs are needed? Unfortunately, no one knew anything about the condition of the bridge because, fortunately, no one at the meeting, recently had to recover a plane from the other side of the ditch.
- Ray Carlson asked if anyone knew the condition of the trainers? Jim Waybright said that everything is in the shed and thought they were in decent shape. Shye Sarig and Steve Hallman said they would check out the condition of the trainers and see if everything is usable for training.
