# Meeting Minutes for July 29, 2025

- MARKS July 2025 membership meeting
- Waybright Field
- 12 members present.
- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Vice President Ray Carlson.
- A motion was made to forgo reading the June minutes. The motion was seconded and approved. There were no changes or corrections to the minutes.

## Treasurer's Report

- Jon Watson was not at the meeting, but Scott Richards reported based on an email that Jon had sent him earlier.
- Major expenses were for rental of the porta potty, and electricity.
- Income was from one member paying dues.
- There have been 34 members that have paid their dues for 2025.
- A motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report. The motion was seconded and approved.

## Field Report

- John Burnett has been keeping the fields and mowers in good shape again this month, and Scott Richards has been keeping the edges trimmed. Jim Waybright and Robert McIntyre have helped out with some of the lawn mower maintenance, replacing starters and batteries. John and Jim worked to get the irrigation sprinklers working a bit more efficiently.
- The John Deere D105 has been performing the bulk of the mowing this season, which has the advantage of consuming less fuel. The blades have been sharpened for the last time.
- Receipts were submitted for the following items:
  - Gas
  - Sprinkler head
  - Mower battery
  - Marksrc.com Domain renewal
  - John Deere D105 blades
- Jim Waybright asked John Burnett which mowers he was using to cut the field. John said he was using the John Deere D105 and the Zero Turn.
- Jim Waybright said the starter replacement on the Zero Turn cost \$100.
- Ray Carlson asked whether since we are only using those two mowers, can we sell the ones we are not using. The consensus was that we need to keep the other mowers in case one or both of the primary mowers break down. It was also thought since they are used, they wouldn't bring much return to the club, if we sell them.

## Safety Report

- Steve Hallman was not at the meeting, so we do not know the condition of the fire extinguishers.

## Membership Report

## Old Business

- Steve Hallman, while at our last meeting, contacted a representative from Horizon Hobbies and they are going to donate an Aero Scout to the club for auction at the October air show. Thank you, Steve.
- Shye Sarig wasn't able to contact Dave Mangione, from the Delaware Radio Control Club, about flying his F-18 jet at our air show. Scott Richards said he would try to contact him through the Delaware Radio Control Club to let him know the date of the air show and see whether he is able to fly.
- John Burnett said he plans to do a candy drop again at the air show and someone suggested we have a Bloody Baron combat competition at the air show.
- Jason Taylor was supposed to contact Bill Young about the potential location and design elements (jumps) for a

RC car track. John Haffner thought he heard that Bill was not in favor of the RC track, but didn't know for sure.

- Shye Sarig checked the condition of the electric powered yellow trainer. He said it runs fine and had it out at the Wor-Wic Summer Scholars event to let a few students fly. He said the batteries are all in good shape. He did not check the gas and glow powered trainers, since he is not familiar with those power systems. John Haffner said he would check out the glow powered trainer.

### **New Business**

- The Bloody Baron combat competition was a success and the pilots flying had fun. It was suggested to move the starting time back to 6:00 pm to allow for more flights. We will change the start time to 6:00 pm.
- A motion was made to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and approved. Meeting was adjourned at 7:18 pm.
- Next meeting is Tuesday, August 26 starting at 7:00 pm. The meeting will be held at Waybright Field. There will also be a Bloody Baron combat competition before the meeting, starting at 6:00 pm.
